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## Principal Report - 28th February 2020

**2020 Classes:** We have started the year with 9 classes with total enrolments of 250 children and strong numbers in both preschool classes. Class teacher Elise Dowd commenced teaching 5/6D in week 4 after Mr Dixon accepted a contract to be the Relieving Teaching Principal at Coffee Camp PS for Semester 1.

Flood Planning: The flash flooding on Thursday 13th February forced the school to be non-operational. Very quickly the entry to the school was cut on two streets. It was good to see that many families accessed information about the school closure through the Skoolbag app, Class Dojo and the school's Facebook page. To improve future communication in an emergency, the school will also send a text message to the registered main contact. The staff worked hard on the Friday to lift most of the contents on the preschool to higher ground. This was on the advice of the school Director Education Leadership who was in contact with SES headquarters. As a result, we have a clear action plan to deal with the flooding of the preschool. I thank all staff for their cooperation and assistance in the move.

**School Interviews / Student Led Conferences** are set for Weeks 7 and 8. 1/2B will have their interviews in Week 6. Parents and carers can book their appointment online at schoolinterviews.com.au using the code vn6j8. Teachers and office staff are happy to support parents with making a booking with this new system.

**Swimming Program:** The Sporting Schools Grant has primarily subsidised the program for 2020. The total cost of the program is \$5.00 for the six week program. We encourage all Stage 2 students to participate and develop their swimming ability.

**Life Education:** All students in years K-4 participated in the Life Education school visit. The school covers the costs of the incursion. Students will have follow up Health lessons in class.

QTR: Our school is continuing their participation in the Quality Teaching Rounds (QTR) project. The research is undertaken by the University of Newcastle. Students who took part in the project last year are invited to continue their participation in 2020. Two new groups of students will also have the opportunity to participate. Participating students will complete surveys and assessments as part of their usual school activities. All names will be removed and only student numbers will be given to the research team so that they can link survey and assessment results with NAPLAN and school attendance data. If you do not want the research team to have access to data, you can opt-out on your child's behalf at any time.
