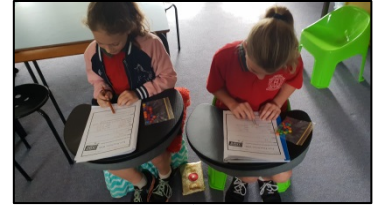

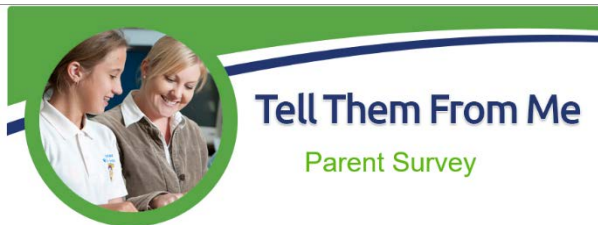
From the Principal
