What has been happening in Preschool?

Echidnas had a colourful week learning about primary colours mixing them to make other colours. Magnets, dinosaurs and babies have been of great interest. We have been learning how to play organised games like 'duck, duck, goose' and 'what's the time Mr Wolf?'. These games are particularly important to teach turn taking and support children to develop a sense of fairness.

The Goannas had a very short week due to the extreme weather, however we managed to investigate some worms that were coming out of the ground. The children expressed wonder and interest in discovering the worms which initiated many conversations. There was also lots of imaginative play with the baby dolls. Role-play allows children to develop their imagination, creative thinking, language skills, knowledge of the world and express feelings. Bread Roll Sushi
